CELTICFEST VANCOUVER 2024

CELTICFEST VANCOUVER CELEBRATES 20 YEARS MARCH 13-17

CelticFest Vancouver, the city's annual celebration of Celtic culture, returns this March celebrating 20 years of bringing Celtic music, dance and culture to Vancouver. Festivities kick off Thursday March 14 with an Irish comedy show hosted by local comedian Amy Walsh and finish Saturday March 16th with an all-day St Patrick's Day festival in the heart of downtown Vancouver. The free, all-ages, community festival offers live music, performances, beer tent, food trucks, Irish dancing, Celtic-themed market, games, Irish Wolfhounds, family zone, face painting, sports demonstrations and more.

CelticFest is Western Canada's largest annual Celtic festival. For 20 years, the festival has delivered a rich cultural celebration of the Celtic nations to thousands of festival goers. In addition to comedy and the flagship downtown festival, ticketed festivities include a performance from the Vancouver Welsh Men's Choir and the annual St. Patrick's Day Ceilidh. Chasing Abbey, a rising Irish pop group from Tullamore, Ireland will headline the festival along with local sensation Paul Caldwell.

The free full-day festival will showcase a range of new and returning performances including music from local favourites like Matty & The Barge Boys and traditional dance by the O'Brien School of Irish Dance. Storyteller Jess Murray and kids' ensemble, the Showstoppers will delight young festival-goers in addition to a family zone with games and activities for all ages. A curated Celtic marketplace will offer everything from international snacks, jewelry, a photo booth and locally made Celtic crafts. Local sports teams and community groups will play games and promote Celtic culture in Vancouver. Cold beer, beverages and a selection of international cuisine will be available through mobile bars and food trucks.

"Over 20 years, CelticFest Vancouver has earned its place as one of the City's most popular celebrations," says Alan Cosgrave, Vice President of the CelticFest Vancouver Board. "Fusing Celtic traditional sounds with modern music, art and celebration, the festival brings people together from around the province. We're very excited to be hosting pop group Chasing Abbey who are coming all the way from Ireland as well as local favorites like Paul Caldwell and the O'Brien School of Irish Dance. In Canada, March is Irish Heritage Month. Irish people have been making their home in Vancouver for decades now and our history here is growing. We're pleased we were able to keep this year's festival a free event so everyone can celebrate."



CELTIC MEDLEY



Doug "Celtic" Medley's explosive fiddling style is an Irish Musical Stew simmering for five decades with lots of ingredients and everything except the kitchen sink.

From electric violin in the San Francisco Acid Rock scene in 1969 to concert master of the North Shore Chamber Orchestra, Doug has enjoyed performing with Vancouver based bands like Foxfire, Blood on the Saddle, Railway, Wallbangers, Quenchers, Halifax Wharfrats, and the legendary music warehouse "City Space" at 343 Railway Street was his creation. Watch the horsehair fly off Doug's violin bow and join him to dance to the Irish fiddle.

CHASING ABBEY



Chasing Abbey are a dance pop trio from Ireland who have honed their artistic talent to create a uniquely Chasing Abbey sound, achieved only by combining the group's pool of talent with each member being a multi-instrumentalist, vocalist and producer.

More recently, Chasing Abbey have revisited their roots as Irish traditional music musicians and are pioneering a new genre of music – 'Trad House' – were they reimagine and rework centuries' old Irish traditional songs and fuse them with their distinctive dance pop sound.

DYLAN MULLEN



County-Monaghan born Dylan Mullen soloist got his start playing guitar at bars in Sligo. When he moved to Vancouver, he continued doing what he loves. IRISH PIPE BAND



The British Columbia Regiment (BCR) Irish Pipes and Drums is an all volunteer band made up of civilians affiliated with the British Columbia Regiment (Duke of Connaught's Own) reserve regiment. In June 2002, the Irish Fusiliers of Canada and the British Columbia Regiment were merged to preserve the Battle Honours and name of the Irish Fusiliers. The band was formed as a visible symbol of the Irish heritage of the two regiments. Under the guidance of Pipe Major Andrew Hayes the band performs at military and civic functions, charitable events, and parades primarily in Metro Vancouver. The band currently practices out of the Beatty Street Drill Hall, home of the BC Regiment.

JAS MINH

JESS MURRAY



Jess is a storyteller, healthcare worker, and social work student from Roscommon, now residing in Snuneymuxw on Vancouver Island. Inspired by her studies with psychologist and mythologist Sharon Blackie, Jess shares the enchanting realm of Celtic myth and tradition through storytelling, as a way to preserve this aspect of our rich cultural heritage.

MATTY & THE BARGE BOYS



Matty Miller and the Barge Boys are Vancouver's most exciting new covers band. Known for their crowd engagement and energy, the Barge Boys bring a wide range of bangers to make your next event one to remember.

MICHAELA CUNNINGHAM & ANDY HILLHURST



Michaela was born in Vancouver and grew up on salt spring island. During her teenage and young adult years Michaela made frequent trips to Ireland to learn Irish music She later studied it at college where she earned a degree in music and an MA in Music performance from Dublin Institute of Technology. Michaela has performed with a number of notable musicians such as Andy Hillhouse, Sharon Shannon, Pierre Schryer, Martin Tourish (of Irish band Altan) and others. She runs a Bed & Breakfast and Spa on Salt Spring Island with her husband.



Andy cut his teeth in the folk world as the founder and manager of the Celtic funk band Mad Pudding, who toured festivals and folk clubs in North America and Europe through the 1990s. Since 2000 he has provided driving, groovy guitar for several of the Celtic music scene's most respected and exciting acoustic musicians, including the Juno Winning McDades, Pierre Schryer, Mark Sullivan, Nuala Kennedy, and Michaela Cunningham. Andy obtained a PhD in Ethnomusicology from the University of Toronto in 2013, and he is currently the Executive and Artistic Director of the Harrison Festival of the Arts in Harrison Hot Springs, BC.

O'BRIEN SCHOOL OF IRISH DANCE

The company creates imaginative and innovative Highland dance that engages and inspires diverse local, national and international audiences on an emotional level. Shot of Scotch Vancouver serves as a cultural and arts ambassador based in Vancouver BC, creating community connections and opportunities that allow adult Highland dancers to thrive beyond their competitive careers.

SHOWSTOPPERS



Perry Ehrlich's ShowStoppers is a GLEE troupe that appears in concert, on radio and TV, and at numerous galas, awards dinners, conventions, corporate and charitable events throughout the Lower Mainland. Upcoming performances include with the legendary group Foreigner at the Abbotsford Centre on May 3 and with the Universal Gospel Choir at the Vancouver Playhouse on June 2. Previous performances include shows with Barry Manilow and Eric Church at Rogers Arena; Canada Day at Canada Place; singing the anthems for the Vancouver Canucks; and at the Pacific National Exhibition. All members of ShowStoppers have participated in Perry's Gotta Sing! **Gotta Dance! musical theatre** summer camp, now heading into its 30th year at the Jewish Community Centre of Greater Vancouver.

SOPHIA STRANG



Sophia Strang is a mezzo-soprano from Surrey, British Columbia. She recently graduated from the Manhattan School of Music with a Bachelor's Degree in Vocal Performance, where she performed the roles of: Fortuna in L'incoronazione di Poppea, and the partial roles of Ursule in Béatrice et Bénédict, and Meg in Falstaff. Sophia also has sung with Classic Lyric Arts Programs in Italy and the Berkshires, performing and studying the roles of Romeo in I Capuleti e I Montecchi, Annio in La Clemenza di Tito, and Cherubino and Marcellina in Le Nozze di Figaro. After meeting at a pub session in Vancouver in 2021, Annika and Danielle have been inseparable as musicians and friends. However, it wasn't until a few years later (and over a couple glasses of wine) that they decided to form a musical duo, and bring their ideas to the performance stage.

Celtic-World-Party-Folk-Rockers The Whiskeydicks brew fiery fiddle, titillating trumpet, giddy guitar, busty bass, delicious drums, and a quaffable quartet of voices to tell legends of good times past, and infuse classic songs in ways one would never imagine.
